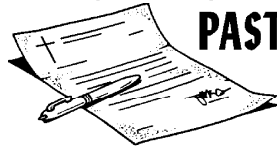

TITLE : THE EKKLESIA: A PEOPLE WHO ARE STRONG IN THE LORD AND IN THE POWER OF HIS MIGHT

Text/s : Eph 5:21; 6:1-18

INTRODUCTION

We not only need to be obedient and submitted to Christ as an Ekklesia. We also need to be "strong in the Lord and in the power of His might" (v 10) as we obey and submit to Him. The following lesson teaches us how we can be effective as we obey Christ as a church.

A) Paul's fourfold exhortation

1) Be strong.

Eph 6:10, "...brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might." We never win battles based on our own strength and power. We can only do so if we are strong in Him and are exhibiting the power of His might.

His Grace makes us strong. 2 Tim 2:1, "...be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus." His Spirit makes us demonstrate His power. 1 Cor 2:4, "...my speech and my preaching was...in demonstration of the Spirit and of power." 2 Tim 1:7, "For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind."

2) Be fully equipped.

Eph 6:11, "Put on the whole armour of God..."

2 Tim 2:21, "...be a vessel unto honour, sanctified, and meet for the master's use, and prepared unto every good work."
Eph 4:22-24, "...put off concerning the...old man...put on the new man..."

3) Be able to stand firm.

Eph 6:11-13, "...stand against the wiles of the devil.....withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand."

Col 4:12, "...stand perfect and complete in all the will of God."

We stand in the grace of God. Rom 5:2, "...we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand..." 2 Cor 1:24, "...by faith ye stand."

4) Be prayerful and watchful.

Eph 6:18, "Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints."

B) The equipping of the strong and powerful believer

- 1) The belt of Truth (v. 14a).
- 2) The body armor of God's righteousness (v. 14b).
- 3) The sandals of the Good News (v 15).
- 4) The shield of Faith (v 16).
- 5) The helmet of salvation (v 17a).
- 6) The sword of the Spirit, the Word of God (v 17b).

VBS POSTS A GOOD HARVEST

Sixty-five volunteers, 7 HAPs, 7 SWYPs and 51 YPs, banded together and for five days led 190 children (ages 4-15) complete the Vacation Bible School (VBS) 2015 with the theme, "Feasting on the Good News of Jesus."

As a result, 31 kids trusted Christ as Savior and 88 made public confession that they have indeed been saved. These children came from four barangays: Tatalon, Dona Imelda, Roxas and Talayan.

Lessons and activities centered around Gospel stories as the Wedding at Cana, the Prodigal Son, the Unforgettable Supper, the Breakfast at the Beach and the Harvest Festival.

ALERT HOLDS MDM IN BAGUIO

The ALERT team with 28 volunteers from Tatalon held the first MDM in Baguio yesterday in partnership with the Metropolitan Lighthouse BBC. A total of 365 patients were extended medical service and 99 of them trusted Christ as Savior.
