Lev 27:30, "...all the tithe of the land... is the Lord's: it is holy unto the Lord."	<u>Tithe</u> The tithes sustain all the general ministry requirement of the whole Lighthouse BBC: people, facilities and sustenance of all ministries.	<u>Faithful Stewards</u> 1 Cor 4:2, "...it is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful." Matt 22:21, "Render therefore unto Caesar the things which are Caesar's; and unto God the things that are God's." Mal 3:8-9, "Will a man rob God? Yet ye have robbed me. But ye say, Wherein have we robbed thee? In tithes and offerings. Ye are cursed with a curse: for ye have robbed me, even this whole nation."

Love – Local Missions Faith – Foreign Missions Mercy – Mission to our communities	<u>Loving Steward</u> 2 Cor 8:8, "...prove the sincerity of your love." 2 Cor 8:24, "Wherefore shew ye to them, and before the churches, the proof of your love, and of our boasting on your behalf."
<u>SHAKEN TOGETHER</u> <u>SHAKEN TOGETHER PROVISION comes as a result of FIRSTFRUITS GIVING</u>	<u>Firstfruits</u> Prov 3:9-10, "Honour the Lord with thy substance, and with the firstfruits of all thine increase: so shall thy barns be filled with plenty, and thy presses shall burst out with new wine."	<u>Firstfruits (Thanksgiving)</u> The Thanksgiving offerings for the whole year are used for various special needs and projects of the church.	<u>Rejoicing and Thankful Steward s</u> Ps 107:22, "...let them sacrifice the sacrifices of thanksgiving, and declare his works with rejoicing."
<u>RUNNING OVER</u> <u>RUNNING OVER PROVISION comes as a result of SACRIFICIAL GIVING</u>	<u>Sacrifice</u> Phil 4:18, "But I have all, and abound: I am full, having received of Epaphroditus the things which were sent from you, an odour of a sweet smell, a sacrifice acceptable, wellpleasing to God."	<u>Sacrificial Offering</u> The Sacrificial Offerings are used for various special needs and projects of the church.	<u>Well pleasing Steward s</u> 1 Peter 2:5, "Ye also...are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ."

The New Testament Giving

God taught the Israelites how to give so that we may learn from them.

Rom 15:4, "...whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience and comfort of the scriptures might have hope."

1 Cor 9:9-11, "For it is written in the law of Moses, Thou shalt not muzzle the mouth of the ox that treadeth out the corn. Doth God take care for oxen? Or saith he it altogether for our sakes? For our sakes, no doubt, this is written: that he that ploweth should plow in hope; and that he that thresheth in hope should be partaker of his hope. If we have sown unto you spiritual things, is it a great thing if we shall reap your carnal things?"

- **It is abounding**
2 Cor 8:7, "Therefore, as ye abound in every thing...see that ye **abound in this grace also.**"
- **It is cheerful**
2 Cor 9:7, "Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give..."

Cheerful implies promptness and willingness.

- **It is bountiful**
2 Cor 9:5-6, "...I thought it necessary to exhort the brethren, that they would go before unto you, and make up beforehand your bounty...that the same might be ready, as a matter of bounty, and not as of covetousness... He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully.

- **It is a proof of love**
2 Cor 8:8, "I speak...by occasion of the forwardness of others...prove the sincerity of your love.

- **It is given in readiness**
2 Cor 9:3, "Yet have I sent the brethren, lest our boasting of you should be in vain in this behalf; that, as I said, ye may be ready:

- **It is equitable**
2 Cor 8:13-15, "...I mean not that other men be eased, and ye burdened...that there may be equality...it is written, He that had gathered much had nothing over; and he that had gathered little had no lack.

- **It is in purpose**
2 Cor 9:7, "Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give..."
