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## INTRODUCTION

How do we define the Christian? We say, "A Christian is a saved person." But when many claim to be saved and to be born again, then how do you distinguish the real Christian?

We say, "A Christian is a disciple. A learner. A follower." But when everybody else claims to be a follower and a learner and the same can talk and look like one, then how do we really know the real Christian?

We say, "A Christian is a light and salt." But the fact is, can we really claim to be light and salt? Ask yourself...Can you really make a claim that you are indeed light and salt?

We say, "A Christian is a child of God." OK...so as a child of God, how do we differentiate ourselves from the children of the devil?

**NOTICE how the Word refers to the Christian...**

**The condition and state of the believer is often described with an attachment. When the Bible says, “ye are bought with a price” it says “therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit which are God's.”**

When the Bible says “Ye are the light of the world...” it also says, “Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your father which is in heaven.”

When the Bible says, “ye are the salt of the earth.” It also gives a solemn warning that “if the salt have lost his saviour, wherewith shall it be salted.” Clearly the Bible wants salt that serves its purpose.

And God's Word is firm - - - He wants a Christian that serves his purpose - in the home, in the church and in the world.

If we are salt - we are salt in every area - the home, the church, the world. If we are light, we are light in the home, in the church, in the world.

If we are saved, we live our being saved in the home, in the church and in the world.

## **A) Christians in the home**

- 1) Keepers of the way of the Lord in the home

Gen 18:19

19 For I know him, that he will command his children and his household after him, and they shall keep the way of the LORD, to do justice and judgment; that the LORD may bring upon Abraham that which he hath spoken of him.

- 2) Doers in the Name of Christ.

Col 3:17-24

17 And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him.

The prison cell where we are in...

Imagine yourself in a big prison cell along with others on death row. You have been with the rest quite some time and you are one with how everyone is in the prison walls.

Rom 7:14-25

14 For we know that the law is spiritual: but I am carnal, sold under sin.  
15 For that which I do I allow not: for what I would, that do I not; but what I hate, that do I.
