**TITLE : THE ENTRANCE AND WORKING OF THE GOSPEL**  
Text/s :

1Thes 1:1-10

1 Paul, and Silvanus, and Timotheus, unto the church of the Thessalonians which is in God the Father and in the Lord Jesus Christ: Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ.

2 We give thanks to God always for you all, making mention of you in our prayers;

3 Remembering without ceasing your work of faith, and labour of love, and patience of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ, in the sight of God and our Father;

4 Knowing, brethren beloved, your election of God.

**5 For our gospel came not unto you in word only, but also in power, and in the Holy Ghost, and in much assurance; as ye know what manner of men we were among you for your sake.**

**6 And ye became followers of us, and of the Lord, having received the word in much affliction, with joy of the Holy Ghost:**

7 So that ye were ensamples to all that believe in Macedonia and Achaia.

8 For from you sounded out the word of the Lord not only in Macedonia and Achaia, but also in every place your faith to God-ward is spread abroad; so that we need not to speak any thing.

9 For they themselves shew of us what manner of entering in we had unto you, and how ye turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God;

10 And to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead, even Jesus, which delivered us from the wrath to come.

## INTRODUCTION

It's amazing how the Gospel of Christ makes an impact to men. For the believers in Thessalonica, look at the change that was wrought in them...

Let us realize that even circumstances are used by God to make us more effective in bringing the Gospel to people around us. The flood that came to us last week show this.

We wonder as to what the Lord intends to accomplish through us as He allows us to go through the flood. We know He has a plan. But how to we appreciate what He does. How do we respond to this as a church?

How God used Paul to reach the Thessalonian Christians tell us a lot of things.

Matt 10:34-40

34 Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword.

35 For I am come to set a man at variance against his father, and the daughter against her mother, and the daughter in law against her mother in law.

36 And a man's foes shall be they of his own household.

37 He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me.

38 And he that taketh not his cross, and followeth after me, is not worthy of me.

39 He that findeth his life shall lose it: and he that loseth his life for my sake shall find it.

40 He that receiveth you receiveth me, and he that receiveth me receiveth him that sent me.

The Gospel entered the Thessalonian people: in Word, in Power, in the Holy Ghost, in much Assurance and in testimony.

## **A) In Word**

### **1 Thess 1:5**

**5 For our gospel came not unto you in word only, but also in power, and in the Holy Ghost, and in much assurance; as ye know what manner of men we were among you for your sake.**

13 For this cause also thank we God without ceasing, because, when ye received the word of God which ye heard of us, ye received it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which effectually worketh also in you that believe.

## C) In the Holy Ghost

### 1 Thess 1:5

**5 For our gospel came not unto you in word only, but also in power, and in the Holy Ghost, and in much assurance; as ye know what manner of men we were among you for your sake.**

(3) It came also “in the Holy Ghost,” or, as the apostle elsewhere phrases it, “*in* demonstration of the Spirit and of power” (<460204>1 Corinthians 2:4). The Word would otherwise have been a dead letter and a killing letter, but the Spirit gave it life. The power of the gospel, therefore, was due to the efficient operation of the Spirit.

### 1 Cor 2:14

14 But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.

4 And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power:

## **D) In Much Assurance**

**1 Thess 1:5**

**(4)** It came also “in much assurance,” not on the part of the Thessalonians, but on the part of the preachers of the gospel, who were fully convinced of its truth, and had thorough confidence in its power.

1 Cor 2:4

4 And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power:

12 In whom we have boldness and access with confidence by the faith of him.

## **E) In Testimony**

**1 Thess 1:5**

**5 For our gospel came not unto you in word only, but also in power, and in the Holy Ghost, and in much assurance; as ye know what manner of men we were among you for your sake.**

(5) This subjective evidence was confirmed by their own recollection of the three preachers of the gospel — “As ye know what manner of men we were among you for your sake.” The Thessalonians would have a very vivid recollection both of the preaching and the preachers. The three brethren were conspicuous by their holiness, their zeal, and their interest in the welfare of the Thessalonians. This was no self-flattery, for it was confirmed by the knowledge of their converts.

Acts 20:33-35

33 I have coveted no man's silver, or gold, or apparel.

34 Yea, ye yourselves know, that these hands have ministered unto my necessities, and to them that were with me.

35 I have shewed you all things, how that so labouring ye ought to support the weak, and to remember the words of the Lord Jesus, how he said, It is more blessed to give than to receive.

33 Even as I please all men in all things, not seeking mine own profit, but the profit of many, that they may be saved.

Therefore seeing we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we faint not;
