INTRODUCTION:

In our text, the Apostl Paul lays down the guiding principles for a relevant ministry in our day... He says, “for the time will come” v 3.

Paul, by the inspiration of the Holy Spirit defines to us how our ministries should be, centuries after his time. He delivered a 5-point guidelines for Timothy (and for us in our day) for us to have effective ministries.

A) Preach the Word like how it should be preached consistent with all ages.

2 Tim 4:2

2 Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine.

2 Tim 4:2

2 Herald and preach the Word! Keep your sense of urgency [stand by, be at hand and ready], whether the opportunity seems to be favorable or unfavorable. [Whether it is convenient or inconvenient, whether it is welcome or unwelcome, you as preacher of the Word are to show people in what way their lives are wrong.] And convince them, rebuking and correcting, warning and urging and encouraging them, being unflagging and inexhaustible in patience and teaching.

B) Have a high sense of awareness.

2 Tim 4:5

5 But **watch thou in all things**, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of thy ministry.

This is the opposite of sleep and being drunk.

This means we need to be more sensitive to the many opportunities (and dangers) that come our way. Many times we waste our time and resources in not having the right response and attitude to people and things (even circumstances) that come our way. We are never aware that everything done for God and His church has eternal value - and we think that they can just be compared with the things that are in this world. Have our minds renewed. Have the mind of Christ. Fear God. Be wise. Be circumspect. Approve the things that are excellent. Be fully aware of these things!

- **See the world and sin.**

Matt 24:3-7

3 And as he sat upon the mount of Olives, the disciples came unto him privately, saying, Tell us, when shall these things be? and what shall be the sign of thy coming, and of the end of the world?

4 And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you.

5 For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and shall deceive many.

6 And ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars: see that ye be not troubled: for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet.

C) Be victorious over every challenge

This is all about increasing the threshold of our spiritual endurance. In the past some of us have been on and off, one day high, the next day low. We were not fixed. We often stumble and fall. But we need to stand strong. We need to be nourished with all the spiritual vitamins so that we may be able to be strong. Then to stand - and stand in full spiritual gear. We are able to weather the trials, problems, negative attitude against us if we are strong in the Lord, in His Word and in His work! We cannot be steadfast, unmovable and abounding - not unless we first be strong to endure.

- Be willing to serve.
- Be willing to suffer. Be willing to be inconvenienced.
- Live sacrificially for God and His work.

Rom 12:1-2

1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

D) Be a deliverer of good things

AMP

To be in church is to be in the saving business of God. And our business is not just to save souls but to save the whole man! That his spirit, soul and body be preserved blameless until His coming! There are those who care about the souls but who do not care that the same soul be saved from corrupt practices and wrong attitude. Some of us cannot even be one with God's people! Some have become pasaway! We want to save people from the error of their ways also! We believe in sanctification - that of our whole being be separated unto God. And we want that all our ministries bear this business!

- Be in the business of saving souls.
- Be in it directly and indirectly.
