INTRODUCTION

Peter gives us some very solid guidelines on how we may live godly. Take note.

Eph 4:23-24

23 And be renewed in the spirit of your mind;

24 And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.

23 And be constantly renewed in the spirit of your mind [having a fresh mental and spiritual attitude],

24 And put on the new nature (the regenerate self) created in God's image, [Godlike] in true righteousness and holiness.

C) The fully persuaded mind

Rom 14:5

5 One man esteemeth one day above another: another esteemeth every day alike. Let every man be fully persuaded in his own mind.

<END GREEK> plerophoreo (play-rof-or-eh'-o); from NT:4134 and NT:5409; to carry out fully (in evidence), i.e. completely assure (or convince), entirely accomplish: KJV - most surely believe, fully know (persuade), make full proof of.

D) The settled mind

2 Thess 2:2

2 That ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand.
