INTRODUCTION

A) The Word of God is Indispensable. Without the Word of God there is no light.

The Word of God is continuously being eased out of all circles today.

- Today we have faith, religion, ministry, gospel which are empty of the Word of God
- Leading of the Spirit without the Word of God
- Claims of

1 Peter 1:25

25 But the word of the Lord endureth for ever. And this is the word which by the gospel is preached unto you.

Be guided by the Word of God

At Thy Word.

1) The Word of God illumines. It illumines us with His will, commands, promises, rebukes, right and wrong.

2) The Word of God is the very measure of obedience and faith

To work for Christ under every possible encouragement is easy and simple enough. But to continue at our post under every discouragement because we believe it is the will of the Lord for us to still strive and sow - that is the trying, the honorable, the acceptable thing. We must not ascribe to God a failure which is due to our own inefficiency.

Hosea 6:3

3 Then shall we know, if we follow on to know the LORD: his going forth is prepared as the morning; and he shall come unto us as the rain, as the latter and former rain unto the earth.

2 Pet 1:19

19 We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts:

B) Faith is Indispensable. Without faith there is no pleasing God.

Heb 11:6

C) The righteousness of Christ in us is indispensable. Without holiness of Christ, there is no fellowship with God.

Heb 12:14

14 Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord:

Rom 6:22

22 But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life.

2 Cor 6:17-18

17 Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you,

18 And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty.

2 Cor 7:1

1 Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.

D) The love of God seen in us is indispensable. Without love there is no profit in anything.

1 Cor 13:1-3

1 Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, and have not charity, I am become as sounding brass, or a tinkling cymbal.

2 And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge; and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, and have not charity, I am nothing.

3 And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, and have not charity, it profiteth me nothing.

Deut 6:5-9

5 And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.

6 And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart:

7 And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up.

Love God above all to be successful.

In love the Lord bestowed his salvation to us. In love, we work out that salvation. In love He gave His Son to us. In love, we give of our selves to Him. In love He sought a way for man to be rescued. In love we seek others to come to Christ.

- 1) The love of God planned the whole redemption. There could not have been life without love. Life therefore is nothing without love.
 - a) The acquisition of all languages is nothing without love. There is no meaning to eloquence without love. Even if you can speak the language of angels.
 - b) The most extensive knowledge is nothing without love. The fact is, knowledge even becomes dangerous without love. Knowledge is a good weapon, but it is dangerous in the hands of people without love.
 - c) The show of almsgiving is nothing without love. The worth of charity is not in what we give but in how we give. It is the motive that gives value to the gift. We may give all our goods yet may not possess love. Men who give without love do not give. They invest. It is not a spiritual act. It is a commercial performance. They invest and expect a return - an applause, a distinction, or something of such nature.
 - d) Though we may show an unlimited surrender and even give our bodies to be burned is nothing without love.
- 2) It was the love of God that profited man
- 3) The love of God returns to Him
- 4) The love of God constrains

Gal 5:6

6 For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision; but faith which worketh by love.

Heb 3:12

12 Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living God.

Heb 3:18-19

18 And to whom sware he that they should not enter into his rest, but to them that believed not?

19 So we see that they could not enter in because of unbelief.

Heb 4:2

2 For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard it.

E) The Lordship of Christ in our lives is indispensable. Without the Lordship of Jesus Christ in our lives, there is there is no fruitfulness, no lasting results.

Put Christ first.

1 Cor 3:11-13

11 For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ.

12 Now if any man build upon this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble;

13 Every man's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is.

9 As we said before, so say I now again, If any man preach any other gospel unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed.

F) The dealing of God as Father to His children is indispensable.

Heb 12:5-13

5 And ye have forgotten the exhortation which speaketh unto you as unto children, My son, despise not thou the chastening of the Lord, nor faint when thou art rebuked of him:

6 For whom the Lord loveth he chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom he receiveth.

7 If ye endure chastening, God dealeth with you as with sons; for what son is he whom the father chasteneth not?

8 But if ye be without chastisement, whereof all are partakers, then are ye bastards, and not sons.

9 Furthermore we have had fathers of our flesh which corrected us, and we gave them reverence: shall we not much rather be in subjection unto the Father of spirits, and live?

10 For they verily for a few days chastened us after their own pleasure; but he for our profit, that we might be partakers of his holiness.

11 Now no chastening for the present seemeth to be joyous, but grievous: nevertheless afterward it yieldeth the peaceable fruit of righteousness unto them which are exercised thereby.

12 Wherefore lift up the hands which hang down, and the feeble knees;

13 And make straight paths for your feet, lest that which is lame be turned out of the way; but let it rather be healed.

9 Whom resist stedfast in the faith, knowing that the same afflictions are accomplished in your brethren that are in the world.

G) The Gospel witness is indispensable.

Rom 10:14-17

14 How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher?

15 And how shall they preach, except they be sent? as it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things!

16 But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Esaias saith, Lord, who hath believed our report?

17 So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.
