INTRODUCTION

2 Peter 1:2-3

2 Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord,
3 According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness,
through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:

The Apostle Peter, in our text, emphasizes that as God's people, we are called to "glory and
virtue", meaning, we are to demonstrate attributes that are glorious and excellent (virtue).

Then the Apostle Paul, in our text, emphasizes the three excellent virtues that we need to show
in the work of the Lord as he writes, "be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work
of the Lord."

It has been suggested that the word "therefore" which introduces the three virtues in our text is
"like the nail on which hang three companion photographs." This three-fold cord comes at the
end of Paul's "Magna Carta of the Resurrection," illustrating that the highest heavenly hopes that
we have, have a most powerful bearing on the everyday work given us to as a church.

Vision enables us to achieve the utmost in our vocation. Paul never divorced position from
practice, doctrine from duty, and our life in Christ in the heavenlies from our life and labor on
earth for Him.

When Paul used the word "therefore" he implied that because of all he had set forth concerning
the fact of the resurrection and the life hereafter, that we should presently live lives worthy of
all that awaits us. As we toil on, awaiting our final salvation from this sinful world, we must not
grow weak and fainthearted, thinking that our work for God and His cause is wasted - because our
"labour is not in vain in the Lord."

What we need to know about the work of the Lord

- What the work of the Lord is

A) Be Steadfast

Although Paul had his visions and revelations, he was no more visionary. Here, as he speaks about the glorious hope that awaits us, he never meant such a blessed future to foster a dreamy sentimental joy, but to be translated into a strong working force.

The word “stedfast” which occurs 20 times in the Bible, is represented by several Hebrew and Greek words. Here, it is presented to mean “a seat,” and denotes one who is seated or settled, and speaks metaphorically of moral and spiritual fixity or stability. Some scholars even think that the word stedfast can be used in a military sense as indicating a “solid front,” meaning, having no

gap in the ranks when marching to battle. Paul commends the Colosians for their steadfastness in Christ.

Col 2:5

5 For though I be absent in the flesh, yet am I with you in the spirit, joying and beholding your order, and the steadfastness of your faith in Christ.

1) God is the perfection of stability

Dan 6:26

26 I make a decree, That in every dominion of my kingdom men tremble and fear before the God of Daniel: for he is the living God, and stedfast for ever, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed, and his dominion shall be even unto the end.

B) Be Unmovable

Marcus Aurelius is credited with having said, "Stand firm like a rock against which the waves batter, yet it stands unmoved, till they fall to rest at last."



The way Paul uses the term “unmoveable” in our text indicate an establishment in the faith as related to assault from temptation or persecution. There is only one other place in the Scripture where the word is used..

Acts 27:41

41 And falling into a place where two seas met, they ran the ship aground; and the forepart stuck fast, and remained unmoveable, but the hinder part was broken with the violence of the waves.

(KJV)

- 1) Be not moved away but continue in faith, grounded and settled

Col 1:23

23 If ye continue in the faith grounded and settled, and be not moved away from the hope of the gospel, which ye have heard, and which was preached to every creature which is under heaven; whereof I Paul am made a minister;

- 2) Be not moved by bonds and afflictions

Acts 20:22-24

22 And now, behold, I go bound in the spirit unto Jerusalem, not knowing the things that shall befall me there:

23 Save that the Holy Ghost witnesseth in every city, saying that bonds and afflictions abide me.

24 But none of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to testify the gospel of the grace of God.

C) Be Always Abounding

The word here “means to overflow,” “to exceed a fixed number or measure;” is used of a flower going from bud to full bloom.

1) Be abounding in love

Phil 4:12

12 I know both how to be abased, and I know how to abound: every where and in all things I am instructed both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need.
